**Fees:** Payment by check or cash is due with registration; A \$50 non-refundable deposit will secure a spot in the class of your choice. Registration fees will cover firing and the first 25# of clay, and use of studio tools and equipment. Additional clay may be purchased for \$20 per bag. Only clay purchased at T Pots Pottery may be fired. **Cancellation Policy:** If cancellation is less than two weeks prior to first class, \$50 will be withheld from refunds. After the first class, no fees are refundable. We reserve the right to cancel classes if the minimum enrollment is not reached; full tuition will be returned. T Pots Pottery is not responsible for providing make up classes. Students may attend another class for make up if space is available. Pottery and tools left beyond 30 days after the end of class become T Pots Pottery property.
